Minutes:

Winter MAP data:

Holly sent out updated MAP data and Council discussed the revisions.

Council should talk to their constituency groups about test results. At this point, the data might lead to additional discussion and looking more closely at specific student data. Reading data was discussed and the potential to look further at school-wide literacy work. What would/could that look like, especially given ELL Title 1 requirements discussed at the last meeting?

Funding Considerations:
