Building Goals:

Council began to discuss the technology and community goals.

Discussion:

- How can we identify students in our classrooms that fall into specific categories? (Reports would be sent from the office)
- We may want to establish a summer session for Council to review fall-to-spring student data so we can use it to inform decisions made during the year.
- There will be a district committee formed in the next few weeks to determine elements to be included in PLPs.
- Curricular department chairs will report out to Council on data assessment done by departments and teams.
- Each department will have a definition of what “high school ready” means to that department.
- Universal curriculum = the curriculum that kids are getting in general classrooms
- It will be helpful to have strong definition/clarification of Personalized Learning Plan vs. Personalized Learning Profile.
- Survey questions can be done via Google Form in the curricular area to which they pertain.
- 2013-14 Annual Report is in the Site Council folder.
- Since technology is universal curriculum, all classroom teachers should be conversant and familiar with terminology used in the NGA test so they can support student learning.
- We may want to break out some of the questions from the student perception survey and ask them multiple times during the school year. There may be some student responses that require immediate intervention. A Google Form would allow us to link responses to individuals so we are able to reach the students in need.
