District Updates:

- School Improvement Process: Site Council focus in the future will be around improving schools. Admin team is currently working on framework for this work that will encourage consistency. Work will begin in August for the following school year. For example, work will begin August 2016 to create a clear picture of goals/objectives for the 2017-18 school year.
- Middle School Site Council Summit: August 24th, 9:00 – noon. This will include Councils from BRMS and SOMS.
- TIF money: There is a one-time amount of over eleven million dollars coming in 2017. This amount has impacts on the district financial picture that are not obvious, e.g. tax implications.
- School Accountability Report Card: DPI will be providing data in Fall of 2016.
- Student Behavior Log: teachers may enter a log entry for any student in the building, but only view the data for students in their groups. Parents don't have direct access to the logs for their children, but may request it. Reminder to staff that other student names should not be included in log entries.

Budget:

Mike shared his appreciation for the hard work and hours put in by all staff.

BRMS budget will remain the same for 2016-17. There is no additional money from the state this year and insurance costs increased. The budget for BRMS has to be determined before hiring can be completed.

Council continued to discuss options for 2016-17 budget allocations.
